About Starmind

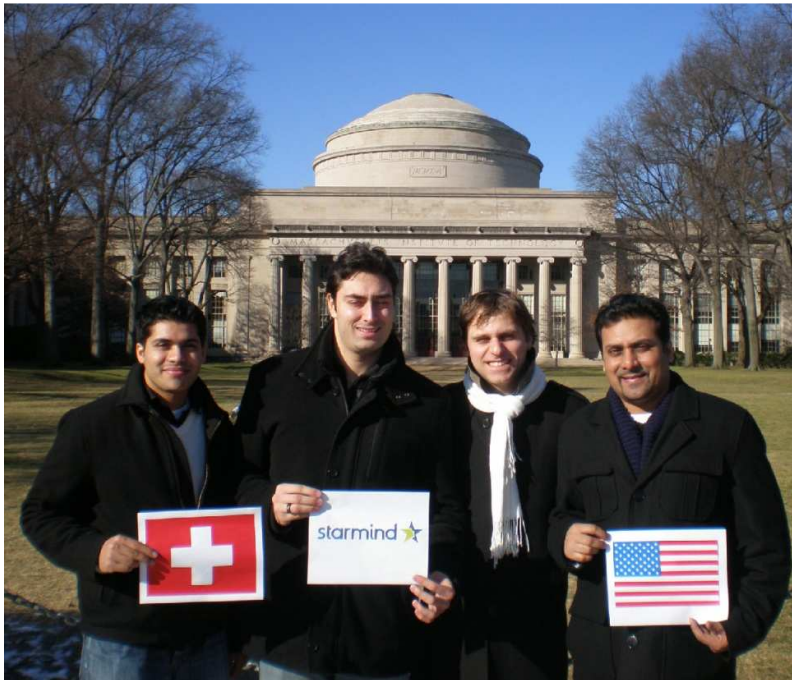
