

# International PhD program

*Frontiers in Genetics* proposes an international PhD program supported by the Swiss National Science Foundation. The program is based at the University of Geneva and includes participating members from the Universities of Lausanne and Zurich, the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology in Lausanne and the Friedrich Miescher Institute (Basel). The program starts in October 2010 and provides a strong background in molecular genetics and genomics for the study of modern biological problems.

We are looking for outstanding candidates with a degree in biological sciences and a commitment to a career in research. The selected students will receive stipends for four years, subject to completion of all program requirements.
