

Doctoral/Postdoctoral positions in human genetics

The groups of Dr Sébastien Jacquemont, Pr. Jacques Beckmann and Pr. Alexandre Reymond are working jointly on a large translational project covering genetics, genomics, neuroimaging, as well as clinical aspects aiming at the characterization of the 16p11.2 rearrangements. These recurrent microdeletion and microduplication syndromes were recently associated with eating disorders, autism and psychiatric illnesses (see Walters et al., Nature, 2010).

We are interested in recruiting talented individuals with strong genetics skills and a background in molecular biology, bioinformatics, genomics or translational science/clinical research.
